8. ESSAY OPTION #2 (for those who do not wish to use an essay previously created):

Choose a book you have read recently. You may also choose a topic you have studied recently in history, science, or any other subject.

Write a coherent, 3-paragraph essay in which you discuss the following questions:

- 1. Tell us about the book you have read or the topic you have studied.
- 2. Why is this book important in relation to other books written on the same subject or in the same time period? Why is this topic significant within the general subject area to which it belongs?
- 3. Why are you interested in this book or topic? 4.

For example, you may choose to write about the crusades. Your essay will look like this:

- 1. First paragraph: what were the crusades? when did they take place? why? who participated in them? etc.
- 2. Second paragraph: why were the crusades a significant historical event? how did they influence other historical developments?
- 3. What sparks your interest in this particular topic?

Each paragraph must be at least 5 sentences long. In addition, you may use direct quotes if you wish. Be sure to proofread for grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Put your name on the first page and include an appropriate title. No cover letter is required.
